


Editing a story







HOW TO MAKE A STORY DYNAMIC




Try to **populate it with verbs** and replace the nominative forms with verbal ones.

Remove unnecessary words. Introductory constructions – thus, in general, so – can slow down the perception of the text.

Use simple sentences. Especially if your story is long, with lots of data, try to make it easier using short sentences.

HOW TO MAKE A STORY MORE CONVINCING



Use **numbers**. For example, instead of "many", "thousands", "millions", use real numbers and make them **clear**. Instead of saying "80% of women" say "8 out of 10 women".

Highlight accents in the story.
Information that accurately hits your goal is important to be highlighted in the overall flow.

In the **text**, there might be quotes and callouts.

In **audio** products it can be fragments marked with special sound effects. In addition, the audio can be emphasized by changing the background.

Reading aloud allows you to look at your story from the outside, without treating it as a product of your own creativity.
